The UK Health and Safety Executive (HSE) recently published the Third Edition of HSG65- *Managing for Health and Safety*.



This Edition is based on the Plan-Do-Check-Act (PDCA) management system, rather than the previous POPMAR system.

To help you understand the differences, and get to grips with the new guidance, we've produced a comprehensive Technical Update, which details all the important changes and information you'll need.
